Tuesday 28th March, 2023

Module 4 – Taking the fear out of fractions

This module will explore the different properties and mathematical structure of fractions. Consideration will be given to the common misconceptions and barriers to learning children may encounter and how the use of the bar model approach supports development of the conceptual understanding of fractions.

Tuesday 22nd May, 2023

Module 5 – Amazing mental maths

This module will explore the essential techniques required to fluently recall and calculate mentally. Consideration will be given to how we promote the most efficient method of calculation and how we can support children in becoming fact fluent

Thursday 22nd June, 2023

Module 6 – Algebra for the totally terrified

Although Algebra is only explicitly mentioned in the Year 6 programme of study there are elements of algebraic thinking in all the year groups e.g., missing number problems in Year 1. This module will explore the barriers and common errors children may encounter and pedagogical approaches to address these.

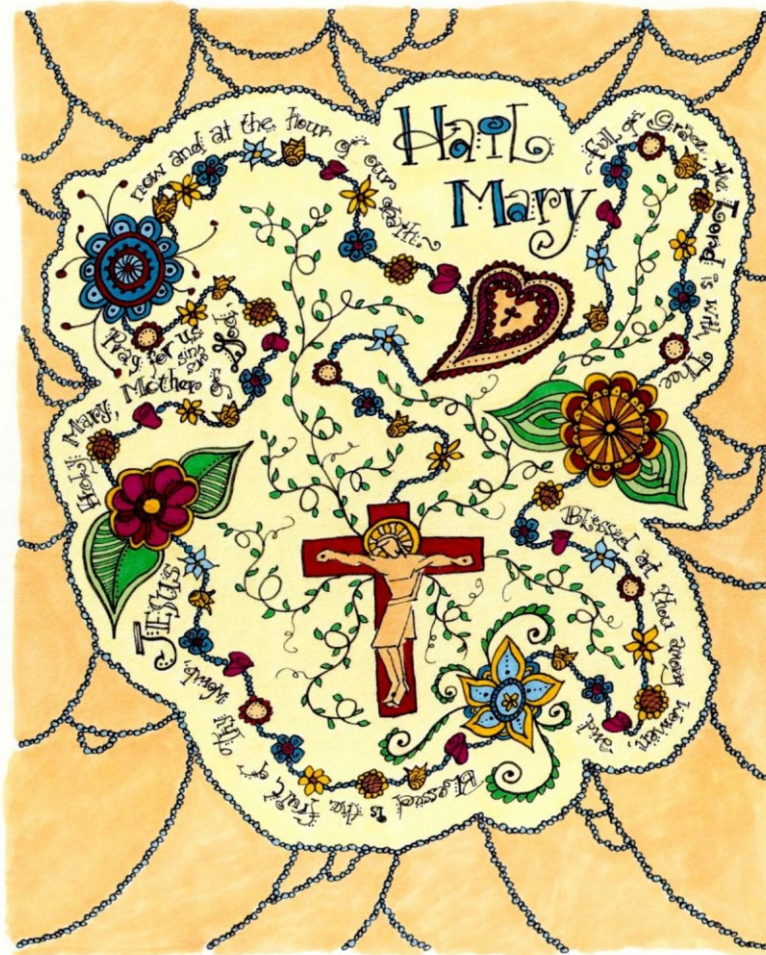
