

Women and people with a womb make up around half of the UK workforce and more than 75% of the UK Teacher workforce. Yet, The Menopause remains one of our few remaining cultural taboos, a topic that is often treated as 'secret' or 'hidden' and seen as not having a place 'at work'.

However, it is essential for team wellbeing and effective organisational cultures that organisation provide information and increase awareness of the Menopause to effectively support individuals through the peri-menopause and menopause transition.
