<u>5 Foundations of Effective Attendance Practice</u>	A brief session to introduce you to the 5 Foundations of Effective Attendance Practice
<u>With Faye Whittle</u>	<p>The 5 Foundations of Effective Attendance Practice framework is modelled on the work of Professor Katherine Weare. The emphasis is on developing a school culture and climate which builds a sense of connectedness and belonging to ensure all children can attend school and thrive. The approach ensures schools prioritise building solid working relationships with children / parents prior to any escalation. The approach allows educational settings to identify triggers early that can lead to poor attendance issues such as mental health issues, lack of trust, communication and relationship breakdowns and the possible lack of networking opportunities both internal (in-school) and external (external agencies).</p>
Thursday 3rd October 2024	<p>The Foundations framework has most recently been reviewed by the Department for Education. The Foundations framework received an excellent report following the four-day review.</p>

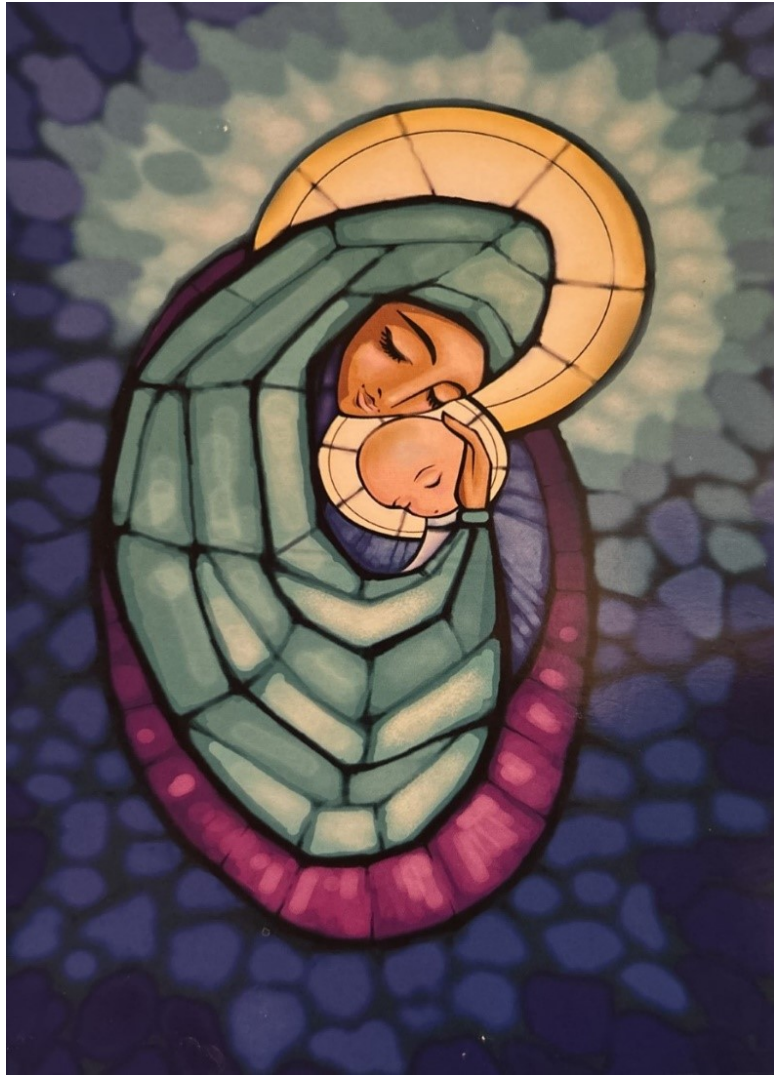
