We know that for some of you, this is your primary role in school, while for others it is one responsibility among many. Whatever your situation, the work you do during those lunchtime hours matters far more than it might sometimes feel. You are not simply keeping an eye on children while they eat and play. You are present with them at one of the most significant parts of their day, and in a Catholic school, how we are present with one another always matters.

Lunchtime is unlike any other time in the school day. It is where children feel free to breathe, to run, to be themselves, and sometimes, in that freedom, the boundaries they hold so well in class can loosen a little. It is also, perhaps because of that very freedom, the time when children are most likely to open up. A child who has said nothing to their teacher all morning may tell you something important over a game of football or a quiet moment by the fence. That is a privilege, and it reflects something we hold dear in Catholic education: that every child is known, valued and loved, and that every adult in a school community has a part to play in honouring that.

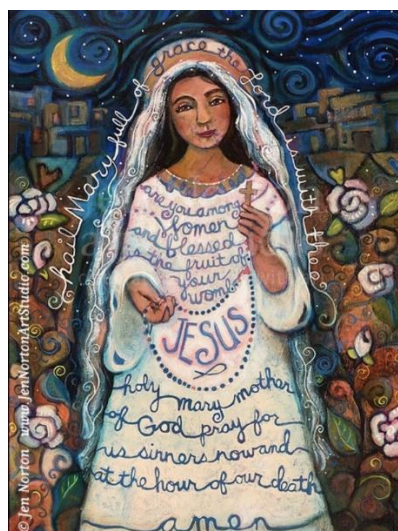

This CPDF offer exists to support you in those moments: to give you practical tools for talking with children, for de-escalating difficulties, and for leading confidently in a space that can sometimes feel unpredictable.
